


About This Guide

- Assessments








Educator Log In

To begin your review, log in to Benchmark Education's digital platform, **Benchmark Universe**.

A unique URL, username, and password has been set up specifically for you.

Google Chrome is the recommended browser, however, the platform is compatible with all modern and updated web browsers.








Locate the Digital Libraries

Benchmark Workshop is available in both print and digital formats. There are also digital-only resources such as music, videos, and an ePocket Chart that are available. All resources are found in the program's digital library, which is accessible directly from the dashboard.

Benchmark Workshop is comprised of modules that combine to offer a comprehensive and complete ELA solution. Each module has an icon on the dashboard.







Navigating the Libraries

The digital libraries organize resources by type. Scroll through each library to browse all resources in each workshop—or use the filters and search bar to find specific resources.

Use the library dropdown menu to switch between workshop resources. *Shown here*: Reader's Workshop


Use the grade-level filter to see resources for a specific grade level.

Additionally, you can filter by unit, week, or resource type.

Once a filter is selected, it will become highlighted. To deselect the filter, click it again.

Resources are grouped by type with headings.

Continue scrolling to explore all resources that align to the filters that you've selected. (Shown here: Reader's Workshop Grade 1, Unit 2)








Launching Resources

Each component can be launched by simply clicking on it. The resources load in a new tab. That way, you always have the library available on the first tab.

To launch a resource, click on its cover image.

Resources will launch in a new tab. The digital library remains on the first tab.








Teacher's Resource System

Click on the TRS cover image to open it. It will launch in a new tab.








Navigating the Reader's Workshop Teacher's Resource System

Navigating the Phonics Workshop Teacher's Resource System



The Benchmark Phonics and Word Study Workshop Teacher's Resource System (TRS) is set up like a mini-website. Instead of scrolling through a very large PDF, the contents of the TRS are broken into sections, which are navigable through an interactive web page.

Daily instruction is provided and accessible using the navigation on the left.

Content is displayed in the main area of the page.

Click on the Additional Resources section to access Cumulative Unit Assessments for Phonics.



Shared Reading

- Display "Look in a Book!" from the Interactive Big Book, pages 14– 15. Tell students to listen as you read the poem aloud. Remind students to visualize, or make pictures in their minds, to help them understand.
- Read aloud the poem. Track the print as you read the first time.
- Ask students to turn and tell a partner something that they visualized. Ask one or two students to share with the class.
- Have students open My Reading and Writing to "Look in a Book!,"
 pages 4–5. Reread and prompt students to track the print. Check
 comprehension. Why do you think the poet says that reading a
 book is a treat? What are some of the characters you could "meet"
 in a book? What are those characters like?



Interactive Big Book, pp. 14–15 My Reading and Writing, pp. 4–5






Navigating the Writer's Workshop Teacher's Resource System

The Benchmark Writer's Workshop
Teacher's Resource System (TRS) is
set up like a mini-website. It is in a
slightly different structure than the
rest of the workshops. The
navigation needs to be revealed by
clicking on the menu icon in the top
left corner of the page.

First, click on the menu icon to navigate the TRS for the volume.

Navigate each volume using the menu on the left. Each week is broken into daily sessions of instruction.






Navigating the Grammar Micro-Workshop Teacher's Resource System

The Benchmark Grammar Micro-Workshop Teacher's Resource System (TRS) is set up like a mini-website. Instead of needing to scroll through a very large PDF, the contents of the TRS are broken into sections, which are navigable through an interactive web page.

Navigate by using the menu on the left


Interactive E-Books



In the digital library, every Mentor Text, big book, decodable text, and small-group text is available as a customizable, audio-enabled interactive e-book!

E-books are assignable so that students can read them any time and anywhere they have an Internet connection. They are great for learning centers, remote learning, and independent reading time.

To launch an e-book, click on its cover image. It will launch in a new tab.







Interactive E-Books, continued


Every e-book includes synchronized audio read aloud by a fluent reader at adjustable speeds. A robust set of tools is available to annotate the text, embed videos from the web, and more. Through assignments, teachers can view students notes, response to questions, and comment on their work digitally.

Click the Play button to listen to synchronized read-aloud audio.

Click the Tools icon to access annotation and zoom tools.

Hover mouse or swipe left (touch device) to advance the page.

Jump to any page or add new pages/embed video in Edit Mode.

Benchmark Phonics and Word Study Workshop includes a digital resource that supports phonological and phonemic awareness, letter/sound correspondence, word study, and more.


The ePocket Chart is an interactive version of the classic physical pocket chart and comes pre-loaded with images, cards, and tools to build your own cards. The ePocket Chart is compatible with interactive whiteboards, tablets, laptops, desktops, and other devices used in classrooms, and can even be assigned to students for remote teaching.

Choose Phonics & Word Study Workshop from the library dropdown menu.

Grades K, 1, and 2 include pre-loaded, pre-set pocket charts for each day's phonics lesson!

There is also an ePocket Chart that includes all cards and resources across the entire workshop.

Use the ePocket Chart filter to quickly find the ePocket Chart.






Return to Dashboard

Click on the Benchmark Universe logo to return to the Dashboard.










As a reviewer, you can also explore the student experience in Benchmark Universe.

Student Dashboard




Students are provided with a dashboard that is focused on accessing their resources and assignments.

Library includes the student e-books.

Assignments shows teacherassigned work for students, including reading, assessments, videos, and more.

Reading Log tracks texts that students have read on the platform to build a reading portfolio.



Inbox provides a way for students and teachers to communicate directly on the platform.








Students are provided with a user-friendly interface that allows them to filter to find their texts.

Use the dropdown menu to find resources from Reader's, Writer's, and Phonics and Word Study Workshops.

Select a grade level.

Select a unit to explore student texts and resources.



Students can build bookshelves of texts and resources for independent reading or research.
